The international, peer-reviewed and open access journal «pl.it / rassegna italiana di argomenti polacchi» is accepting submissions for its thirteenth issue (2022).

The year 2022 marks the official Year of **Polish Romanticism**, celebrating the bicentenary of the first volume of Adam Mickiewicz's *Poezyje* (including *Ballads and Romances*), the commonly accepted starting point of traditionally understood Polish Romanticism. This can be a unique opportunity to renew the critical debate on Polish Romanticism, on the long-lasting Romantic paradigm (martyrology, messianism, etc.), a debate initiated by the positivists, continued by Gombrowicz and Maria Janion, and lasting until today. We therefore also welcome contributions that fit into this strand of studies and reinterpret the period, its ideas, ideologies and myths, as well as the related cultural texts.

The year 2002 is also the anniversary of birth or death of several important Polish writers, including **Maria Konopnicka**, **Miron Białoszewski**, **Tadeusz Borowski**, and **Władysław Broniewski**. You may find inspiration in rereading and reinterpreting the works of these important figures and in the issues connected to their reception in Poland and elsewhere. Certainly, there are also other significant historical or cultural events that may become stimulating topics for your research. Submissions of papers devoted to other aspects of Polish **literature and culture** are equally welcome, as well as on **language and translation** topics.

The papers may be written in Polish, Italian or English. The deadline for submitting the definitive text of the papers is 28 February 2022. Notification of acceptance or rejection will be communicated by 30 April 2022. The issue is planned for publication in December 2022.

Proposals for contributions, with title, a short abstract (800-1000 characters) and a brief profile of the author (500-700 characters) should be sent to [segreteria.plit@gmail.com](mailto:segreteria.plit@gmail.com). The articles should not exceed 45,000 characters (including bibliography and footnotes). Please note that the papers submitted to the journal must be original, hitherto not published elsewhere in any language. Each paper will be submitted to double-blind peer review before being accepted for publication.
